TREES & ME: GEORGIA PLT'S EARLY CHILDHOOD INITIATIVE

Georgia Project Learning Tree (PLT), in partnership with the STEAM Center for Creativity and Innovation at Valdosta State University (STEAM Center), had the privilege of providing four professional development (PD) opportunities to Middle and Southwest Georgia Head Start Programs. Two hundred of their early childhood educators were successfully trained PLT's Trees & Me curriculum. Activities included PLT's Trees & Me curriculum through whole group and "station-style" experiences. Facilitators demonstrated how the curriculum correlates to the Head Start Child Outcomes Framework and the Georgia Early Learning and Development Standards (GELDS). These PD courses utilized a three-and-a-half-hour in-person learning session, designed by Georgia PLT to connect educators to STEM Strategies, GELDS, and curricula used by several Head Start Programs.

After the PD events, trained educators received even more than the knowledge of PLT's curriculum. Each Educator earned a certificate of completion with contact hours to further their continuing education through Bright from the Start. Educators also walked away with resources and physical teaching tools to help them in the classroom and the opportunity for a chance to win a \$100 gift card by completing an implementation follow-up form. As a result of the success of this initiative, beginning in September of 2022, Southwest Georgia Head Start integrated PLT's Trees & Me into their Learn Everyday curriculum.
